SKF kit replacement: VKMA 01275 is replaced by VKMA 01130



OE #: 038 198 119 F

In accordance with OE specifications, the difference between the SKF timing belt kits VKMA 01130 and VKMA 01275 is the belt - both belts have same physical dimensions, but a different construction.

In-line with the OE belt material change, the belt included in the VKMA 01130 kit has been manufactured with a stronger construction. Today, car makers only use this unique, reinforced belt in the kits - therefore, SKF has also superseded the VKMA 01275 kit with VKMA 01130.

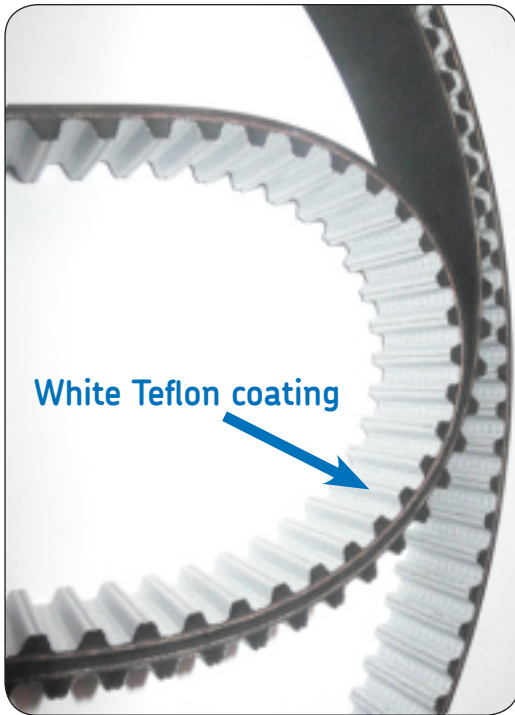
With this OE evolution and specification change, the belt material has been modified and now includes a Teflon coating.

The Teflon coating/design ensures a stronger resistance and extends the timing belt kit change interval from 90,000 to 120,000 km (or 5 years, whichever is soonest).
